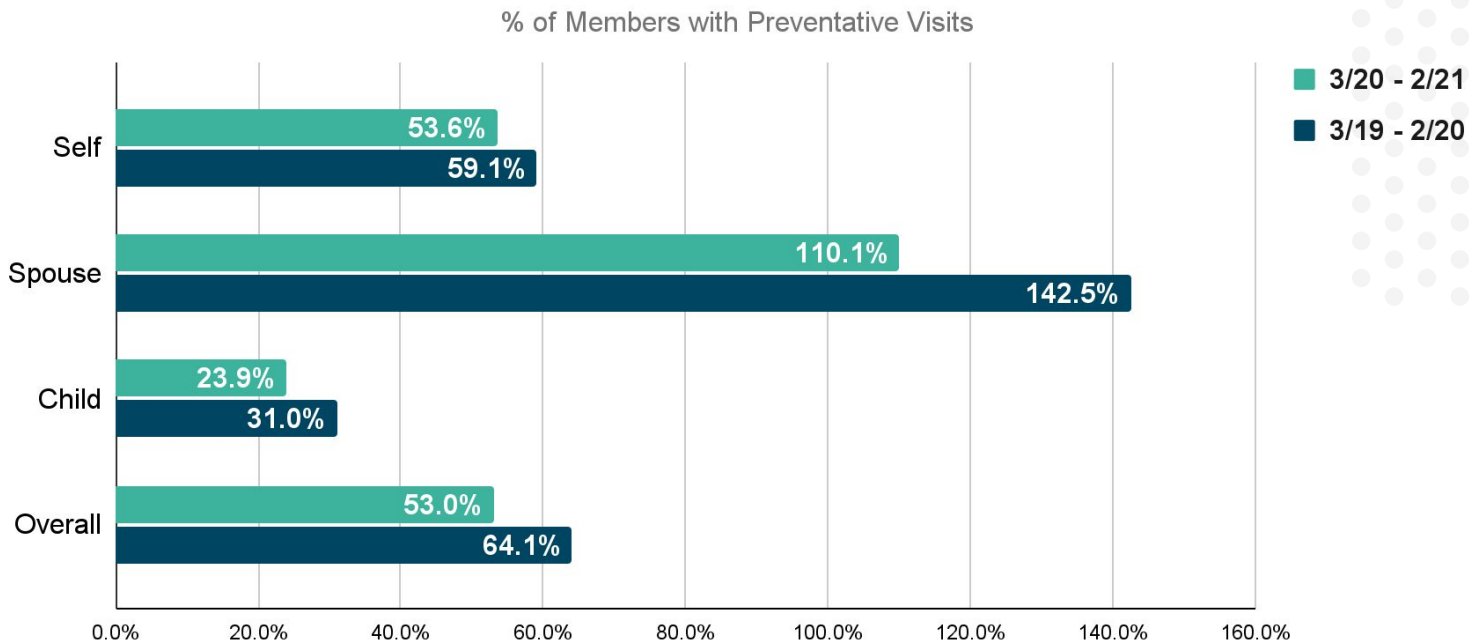


Preventative visits are on the decline and your health risk scores are on the rise

Preventative visits declined over 10% from 64.1% to 53.0% during the period



Thought: For members with chronic conditions who may have forgone routine visits over the most recent period, how will this affect their future health risk going forward?

Changes in Preventative Visits and Future Risk Scores		
Generational Band	Decrease in Preventative Visits	Increase in Future Risk Scores
Gen Alpha (2010-24)	-15.6%	13.2%
Gen Z (1997-2009)	-7.4%	17.3%
Millennials (1981-96)	-11.6%	7.2%
Gen X (1965-80)	-13.3%	7.7%
Baby Boomers (1946-64)	-11.6%	4.5%
Silent Gen (1928-45)	0.2%	7.0%

There is also a significant decrease in the percentage within each age band that sought preventative care year over year.

Based on claim trends comparing the period, the data forecasts increases in member's future risk over the next 12 months across all bands
